I wanted to pray for his friend so I asked for his name. However, Cee-Horne said that it was not just one (The Chinese language do not use plural so one can be mistaken to hear 'friends' as 'friend'.). I was really surprised so I asked him why so many friends have passed away?

He replied that because he's graduating, he wouldn't be able to see his friends from school. He was still very upset as he was telling me this. I really admire this pure and innocent love that Cee-Horne has. This is a treasure that modern people have lost. I remember when I was young, I also had this pure and innocent love. I cried for ten days over the death of my dog; I cried when I worried for my late mother's passing; and I was teary when the cousins I grew up with migrated overseas. But this pure and innocent love I had gradually faded as I grew older.

God's church is different than our world. However, there are still things that are beyond our control. But remember, the most important thing is to please God and to seek His wills! Do we appreciate what our brothers and sisters do? Or do we only focus on things that are not set in our way? Let me encourage myself and also encourage you here to learn together to be someone who is always dedicated to God and walk with Him!
